- II. Officer Reports

 - B. **Treasurer** (Kayci LeFlore, absent): Total assets \$85474.22. That does include the gross revenue from fall fundraiser of \$26,067.88 but we have not paid the fundraiser vendor his portion. Also thinking of painting the mirrors instead of purchasing new since budget doesn't cover enough. Will purchase and hopefully install in late November.
