II. Officer Reports

B. Treasurer (Kayci LeFlore): Total assets of \$76,133.37- does not include auction revenue. We paid for the inclusion speaker, author, luncheon and teacher grants. We made $\$ 661.50$ on the used book sale.

We approved 5 grants (robots, 3D Printing material, math/reading centers, PE Balls/equipment). We have used all of our laminating budget. We need to order more but will still be under the $10 \%$ overage. Probably will need to increase this budget next year.

We had some schedule conflicts this year which might account for smaller attendance. We have profit of around $\$ 28,000$. Rough estimate net profit of $\$ 20,000$. Heads and Tails extra lives and Best of Live went well and made extra money. We are looking into doing a Trivia Night next year.
