


**VOLUNTEERS NEEDED!**

**PTC works continuously to put the money donated through fundraisers to good use. This year PTC has organized and funded the following projects:**

- **PTC hosted Lisa Wheeler, award winning children's author. Mrs. Wheeler engaged the students in 3 different presentations during the school day and joined us for Family Reading Night. Thank you to all who helped make her day at Farmingdale special. She commented on how well behaved all the students were.**
- **The used book sale that accompanied Family Reading Night was a huge success! Over \$700 was raised to off-set the cost of Lisa Wheeler's visit. Thank you to all who donated books, helped with set up, take down, and purchased books!**
- **PTC partners with Reading Is Fundamental, RIF, to provide new books to students in 3rd and 4th grade 3 times a year. The students get to pick out their own books at no cost to them and take them home that same day. If your student brings home a new book and mentions it is a "RIF" book, this is that program.**
- **PTC provides tickets for select grades to attend plays or performances at University of Illinois Springfield called Class Acts. In February, the first grade classes attended Aesop Bops! The 3rd grade classes attended Frindle recently and the 4th grade classes will be able to attend Number the Stars this Spring.**
